When will the renovation begin?

The kitchen cabinets have been emptied and renovation is scheduled to begin on June 22.

When will the kitchen renovation be complete?

We anticipate being back in the kitchen by October 1 at the latest.

What other projects are beginning immediately?

Replacement of the metal steps leading to the parking lot (from the kitchen & gym) will take place very soon.

Who is overseeing the project?

Jane Snyder has oversight of the kitchen renovation.

John Earnhardt and members of the Property Committee are working with other contractors to accomplish some of the smaller projects.

What about the money?

As of Tuesday, June 16, pledges in the amount of \$117,000 have been received. This includes cash in the amount of \$55,750. We look forward to receiving strong support from the entire congregation as we move toward the campaign goal of \$200,000.

Mission Trip to Mwandi, Zambia

The Mwandi, Zambia mission trip participants will depart on July 31 and, after a long flight, will arrive late in the evening on August 1. While there, they will participate and serve in a number of areas. A priority will be to visit the surrounding bush villages to assess the clean water needs of the people. Participants from First Presbyterian are Rich and Janet Schaefer, Richard and Joyce Lambert, Andy Cotton, and Matt Drumheller. We will be joined in Mwandi by Kathy and Winston Faust from Pearisburg Presbyterian Church, Pearisburg, VA. Kathy and Winston have been a part of our Mwandi group since our first trip in 2008.

We can all participate in their trip by providing any of the following needed items:

Gauze
Cotton Balls
Thermometers

Materials are needed for a new *special needs* class. Students range in grades 1 through 6. Books for pupils with intellectual disabilities:
