Action by congress at the end of 2015 will increase U.S. support of development assistance for

farmers in Africa and elsewhere.



Bring the entire family out to a movie with friends, popcorn, candy & drinks!!! Cozy up in your chair or blanket and plan to relax and laugh out loud!!!


